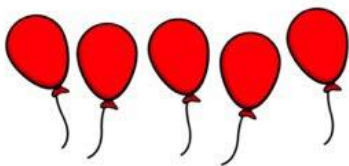

KS2 Problem Solving Questions

Monday 20th March 2017

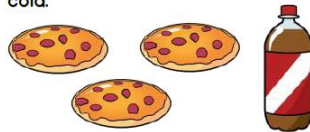
- 1 Dev has a 3kg bag of flour.



He uses $\frac{7}{10}$ kg of the flour to make a cake and uses 0.65kg to make some bread.

How much flour has he left?

- 2 Mina buys 3 pizzas and a bottle of cola.



A pizza costs £3.20 more than a bottle of cola.

The total cost of the items is £19.40

How much does a pizza cost?
