Improving behaviour at school

We are pleased to announce that our negative behavior incidents log continues to decline, term on term. Miss Morrell analyses all incidents that are reported so that we can support our pupils.

Last half term there were 106 reported incidents compared to 241 in Autumn 1. That is a significant reduction and the children report that playtimes are much happier times. The bullying incidents have also declined to 5 reported cases last term. These incidents were repeated negative behavior or intended to hurt someone either physically or emotionally. Senior leaders take a zero tolerance on bullying.
